Project requirements

School contours enabled students to jump onto a hall roof then onto an adjacent grassy bank. Hall roof was being damaged in the process. Provide fencing to prevent students from jumping from roof to grass bank.

Warner recommendation

Balmain steel fencing, part of the unique Futura fence system, incorporating upright spikes. Spikes act as physical deterrent. Powder coated black to blend with school buildings and enhance visual appeal.

Installation

Project run in association with John Bannatyne Architects.

Outcome

A good looking fence that prevents students jumping onto bank, resulting in no further jumping onto hall roof. Prevented any further damage to school property. Delivered on time, to budget.
